1. VEED.io

What it is:

Online video editor with AI-powered features

Best for:

Creating social media content, adding subtitles, removing background noise

Why it matters:

Edit videos 4x faster than traditional software. Auto-subtitles in 100+ languages, AI eye contact correction, voice cloning, and Magic Cut (removes filler words automatically). Free plan available.

2. NotebookLM

What it is:

Google's AI research assistant that turns your documents into podcasts

Best for:

Research, learning, synthesising information from multiple sources

Why it matters:

Upload PDFs, Google Docs, YouTube videos, websites, and more. Get instant summaries, create AI-generated podcasts ("Audio Overviews"), and ask questions about your sources. New "Deep Research" feature browses hundreds of websites for you and generates comprehensive reports. Completely free.

3. ChatGPT / Claude (with Projects)

What it is:

AI chatbots with project workspaces

Best for:

Writing, brainstorming, coding, problem-solving, research

Why it matters:

Create separate "Projects" for different contexts (work, personal, specific topics). Upload documents, set custom instructions, and maintain conversation history. Context engineering is key — the better you structure your projects, the better outputs you get. Free versions available, paid plans unlock more power.

4. Otter.ai

What it is:

AI-powered meeting transcription and note-taking

Best for:

Meetings, interviews, lectures, capturing ideas on the go

Why it matters:

Real-time transcription with speaker identification. Auto-generates summaries and action items. Records audio and creates searchable transcripts. Never miss a detail in meetings again. Free plan includes 300 minutes/month.

5. Bolt.new / Lovable

What it is:

AI-powered no-code website/app builders

Best for:

Building MVPs, landing pages, web apps without coding

Why it matters:

Describe what you want to build, and AI generates a working website or app. Perfect for testing ideas fast. I built my personal operating system (mysoullens.com) with Bolt in under 5 hours for about \$20. Incredible for non-technical founders.

6. Notion

What it is:

All-in-one workspace for notes, projects, and databases

Best for:

Personal project management, note-taking, knowledge organisation

Why it matters:

Combine notes, tasks, databases, and wikis in one place. Create custom dashboards for your life/work. AI assistant helps with writing and summarising. Free for personal use, scales beautifully.

7. Huxe

What it is:

AI-powered personalised podcast generator (from NotebookLM creators)

Best for:

Daily briefings, learning about topics hands-free, staying informed

Why it matters:

Connects to your calendar and email to create personalised audio briefings every morning. Create instant "DeepCast" podcasts on any topic you're curious about. Interactive — you can interrupt and ask questions mid-podcast. Perfect for commutes and workouts.

8. Leonardo.ai

What it is:

AI image generation platform

Best for:

Creating stunning visuals, graphics, artwork without design skills

Why it matters:

Generate professional-quality images from text descriptions. Multiple models for different styles (realistic, artistic, anime). Perfect for social media content, blog headers, presentations. More control than Midjourney, easier than Stable Diffusion. Free credits daily.

9. Wispr Flow

What it is:

AI-powered voice-to-text dictation tool

Best for:

Writing 3-4x faster than typing, hands-free productivity

Why it matters:

Works in every app on Mac, Windows, and iPhone. Automatically removes filler words, corrects grammar, and formats appropriately for each app (emails vs messages). Learns your voice and vocabulary. Context-aware — understands names, technical terms, and your writing style. Game-changing for anyone who thinks faster than they type.

10. Canva (AI Features)

What it is:

Graphic design platform with AI tools

Best for:

Creating professional graphics, presentations, social media content

Why it matters:

Magic Design creates full designs from a single prompt. Background remover, AI image generator, and text-to-image built in. Thousands of templates. If you're not a designer, this makes you look like one. Free plan is generous.

- **ChatGPT or Claude — Set up one project for work, one for personal. Use it daily for a week.**
- **NotebookLM — Upload 3 documents about a topic you're researching. Try the Audio Overview feature.**
- **Otter.ai — Record your next meeting or lecture. Experience never taking notes again.**

Once comfortable:

- Add Wispr Flow if you hate typing
- Try VEED.io for your next social media video
- Use Bolt.new to build that idea you've been sitting on
